Thank you for your patience during the traffic chaos whilst the diversion was in place. Thankfully, the roads are now fully open.

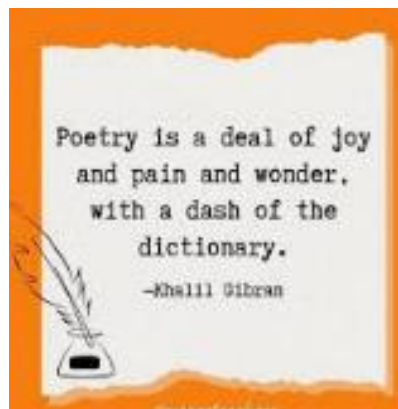
### The Park

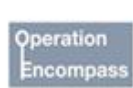
## Half Term
