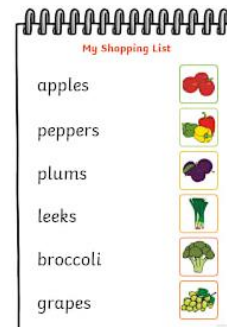


## Year One Homework : 10th October
