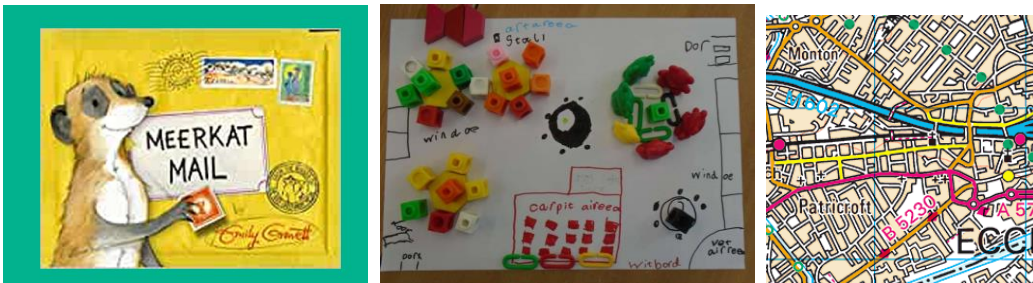


Year One Homework : 3rd October
