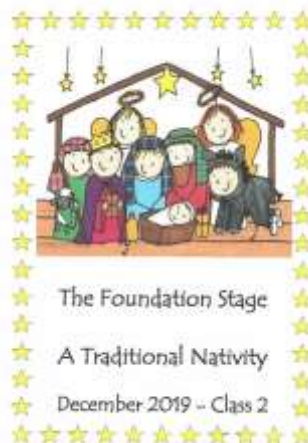
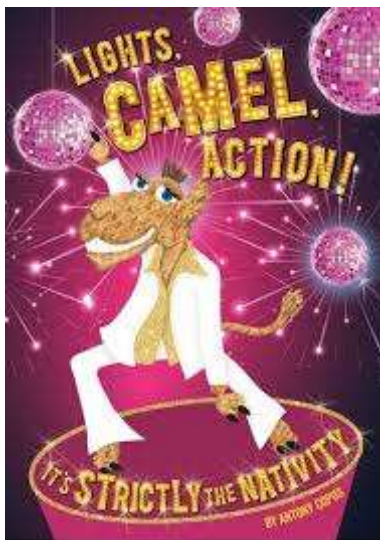


Year One Homework : 21st November

Learning in school : In Year One this week we have begun to learn our Christmas production. For an additional homework this week, would you like to take part in a competition?
